

ElderHomes Corporation is a non-profit community development corporation whose mission is, "to improve the housing and living conditions of low income, older adults, and persons with disabilities within the greater Richmond area." We were founded in 1992 by the Capital Area Agency on Aging (now Senior Connections) to focus on the housing needs of seniors.

Since our inception, we have completed over 7,800 projects including minor home repairs, energy efficiency improvements, wheelchair ramps, and major rehabilitations throughout our service area. ElderHomes has developed and operates six multi-family housing developments for low and moderate income seniors, and produces six to ten high-quality, affordable, single family infill development homes each year.

ElderHomes owes its stability to the diversity of its funding sources, which include public and private grants and corporate and personal contributions. ElderHomes owes its success to its volunteers and staff who work to consistently provide high quality service to its clients. In 1998, it launched its Volunteer Minor Home Repair Program and currently offers opportunities for individuals, corporations, faith communities, and civic groups to volunteer in their communities performing minor home repairs, building wheelchair ramps and performing yard work.
